DATE	THEME	YOU NEED TO HELP YOUR CHILD AT HOME WITH THESE IDEAS:
17-19 January	My School	Talk to your child about their daily routine at school, about the different activities they will do, i.e. painting, singing songs. Ask questions like "What is the name of your teacher and your school? Talk about how they feel - sad, scared, happy, unsure. Pray together for school.
22-26 January	My Body (God Made Me)	Sing songs: "Tommy thumb, Tommy thumb where are you?"; "Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes, Knees and Toes" Also talk about personal safety – what are the child's private parts and who can touch them. Talk about different body parts.
29 January - 2 February	Senses	Talk about the senses: we see with our eyes, hear with our ears. Let your child taste different flavours like sweet, sour and bitter. Touch different textures e.g.: rough bricks, smooth paint, soft material. Listen to music and explain to them what they are hearing - voice, drum,
5-9 February	Safety	Talk about safety. (Stop, look both ways and listen when crossing a road. Never run across the road.) Tell your child about stranger danger; only accept food and lifts from an adult that they know. Do not play with matches, candles or electric appliances. Only play in areas where there is nothing sharp or dangerous. Never tease dogs- you might get bitten.
12-16 February	My Family	Read children's books about families to your child. Learn "I love you, you love me, we're a happy family". Talk about family members e.g. brothers, sisters, fathers and mothers. Share family traditions and stories. Pray as a family together.
19-23 February	Shapes	See how many different shapes you can find when out and about, i.e. houses have rectangles for windows. Draw hopscotch (scotch) with chalk and instead of numbers add shapes. Jump on the different shapes while naming them.
26 February - 1 March	Colours	Colour Week! Please dress your child in these colours this week: Monday- Blue, Tuesday-Yellow, Wednesday – Green, Thursday- Red, Friday- Orange or Purple
4-8 March	Summer	Is it hot or cold in Summer? How do we protect ourselves from the sun? Hat, Sun Cream. It also rains in Summer. Explain what thunder and lightning really is. Let your kids jump in puddles after it rains. Make a nice summer fruit salad and enjoy it with your child in the garden.
11-15 March	People that Help (Careers)	Tell your child about the jobs family members have. Talk about different people that help us and what they do: Nurse, Doctor, Policeman, Fireman, etc
18-22 March	My House	Where do families live and the different rooms in a house i.e. bedroom, kitchen. Teach your child their physical address and phone number.
25-28 March	‡ Easter	Read the story of Jesus' crucifixion (Matt:26-28). Pray together as a family and thank Jesus for what he has done on the cross so that we all can go to heaven. Make a garden to resemble the burial site of Jesus - crosses from sticks and a cup and stone for the tomb.
